The Vinyl Siding Trap

Vinyl siding is durable, but it isn't invincible. The green algae (*Gloeocapsa Magma*) that grows on the north side of your house produces acids as it metabolizes. If left for years, this algae can permanently stain the vinyl. Even after you finally wash it, you might be left with "shadows" or discoloration that cannot be removed. At that point, your only option is to replace the siding—a cost of \$15,000 to \$20,000—all because you skipped a \$400 wash.

Rotting Wood Trim

Many MA homes have wood trim, fascia, or clapboard. Mold and mildew hold moisture against the wood. Moisture is the catalyst for rot. If your paint is covered in mildew, it will start to peel and flake prematurely. Once the paint barrier is broken, water enters the wood, and rot begins. Regular power washing removes the mildew, allowing the wood to dry out and extending the life of your paint job by years. Painting a house costs thousands; washing it is the cheapest way to protect that investment.

Roof Life Expectancy

Those black streaks on your roof are eating the limestone in your shingles. This loosens the granules. A roof without granules becomes brittle in the sun and cracks. Insurance companies are now using drones to inspect roofs. We have seen homeowners in Massachusetts get "Cancellation Notices" from their insurance carriers because their roofs look dirty and "end of life." A soft wash can restore the look of the roof, satisfy the insurance company, and extend the shingle life by 5-10 years.

The Insect Connection

Spiders, wasps, and carpenter ants love dirty, undisturbed areas. Thick cobwebs under your eaves catch insects, which attract spiders. The dirt acts as an anchor for wasp nests. Regular power washing sweeps away these webs and nests, making your home less hospitable to pests.

The Cost of "Eventually"

Waiting until the house is "really dirty" is a false economy. The harder the stains set in, the harsher the chemicals needed to remove them, and the higher the risk of permanent damage. A bi-annual maintenance wash is gentle, effective, and cheap compared to the restoration costs of neglected siding.
