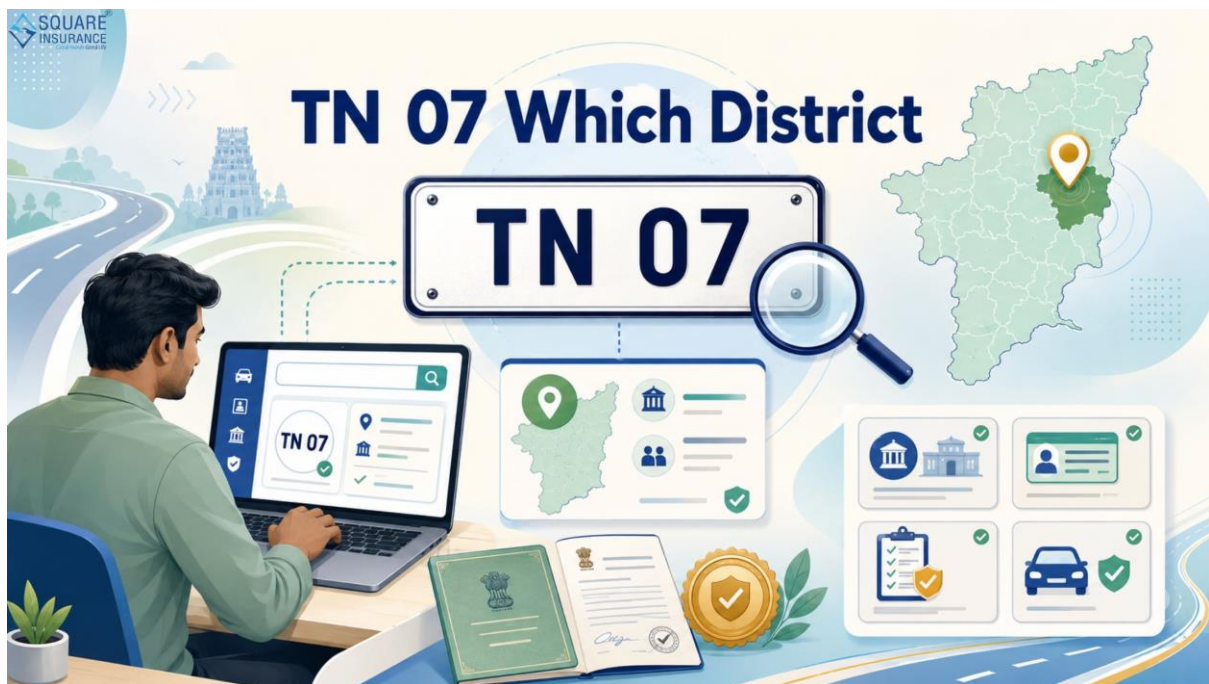


How to Check TN 07 Which District Is Assigned Under Tamil Nadu RTO Code
