

Germany Student Visa 2026–2027: Step-by-Step Guide for Indian Students

Germany continues to be a popular destination for Indian students because of its internationally recognised universities, strong research opportunities and wide range of English-taught programmes.

If you are planning to study in Germany for the **2026–2027 intake**, understanding the student visa process early can help you avoid unnecessary delays and document mistakes.

This guide covers the key steps, documents, financial requirements, APS, application process and important points Indian students should know.

Do Indian Students Need a Germany Student Visa?

Yes. Indian students planning to pursue a long-term degree programme in Germany generally need a **German national visa (D visa)** before travelling.

The visa application is separate from university admission. Receiving an admission letter does not automatically mean that your visa will be approved.

Your application needs to demonstrate that you meet the relevant requirements for studying and living in Germany.

Germany Student Visa Requirements 2026–2027

The documents required can vary depending on your programme and personal circumstances. Common requirements include:

- Valid passport
- German university admission letter
- APS certificate, where applicable
- Academic certificates and transcripts
- Language certificate
- Proof of financial resources
- Health insurance
- CV
- Motivation or study-plan letter
- Visa application documents
- Biometric photographs
- Additional documents requested by the German authorities

Always use the latest checklist applicable to your visa category and place of application.

Step 1: Get Admission to a German University

Your first major step is choosing an appropriate programme.

Before applying, check:

- Academic eligibility
- Course curriculum
- Language of instruction
- Tuition fees, if applicable
- Semester contribution
- Application deadline
- Admission requirements
- Career opportunities

Germany has both public and private universities, so students should compare programmes rather than choosing a university solely because it has low tuition fees.

Step 2: Check Your APS Requirement

For many Indian students, **APS certification** is an essential part of the Germany study process.

APS India verifies academic documents from India and issues an APS certificate to eligible applicants.

Start this process early because APS verification can become an important dependency for your subsequent application planning.

Students should also check whether any current APS changes apply to their specific academic background or intended programme.

Step 3: Prove Your Financial Resources

One of the most important Germany student visa requirements is proof that you can support yourself during your stay.

For 2026, the blocked-account requirement for students is currently:

€11,904 per year

or:

€992 per month.

Depending on your circumstances, other accepted forms of financial proof may include a qualifying scholarship or a formal Declaration of Commitment from an eligible sponsor in Germany.

Financial requirements can change, so verify the amount before submitting your application.

Step 4: Arrange Health Insurance

Health insurance is another essential part of your Germany student visa preparation.

Students need appropriate health insurance coverage for their stay in Germany and must provide the required documentation during the visa process.

Do not treat insurance as a last-minute requirement. Arrange it according to the dates and conditions applicable to your visa and university enrolment.

Step 5: Prepare Your Language Certificate

Your language requirement depends on the programme.

For English-taught courses, universities may require an accepted English-language qualification.

For German-taught programmes, you will generally need the German-language qualification specified by the university or programme.

Make sure the certificate you submit is actually accepted for your specific application.

Step 6: Apply for Your Germany Student Visa

Germany has introduced more digital processing through the **Consular Services Portal**.

Where your visa category is supported, you can begin the national visa application online, upload documents and receive preliminary feedback before proceeding with the required in-person steps.

Online submission does not necessarily mean that the entire process is remote. Applicants may still need to appear personally for biometrics and other required procedures.

Step 7: Attend the Required Appointment

At the appointment, applicants may need to provide:

- Biometric information
- Original documents
- Supporting documents
- Visa fee
- Additional information requested by the authorities

Make sure your documents are organised according to the current checklist.

Germany Student Visa Fee

The standard national visa fee for adults is generally **€75**. The exact INR equivalent depends on the applicable exchange rate and the German mission's current fee information.

Additional expenses may include APS, language tests, translations, document verification, insurance and other application-related costs.

Germany Student Visa Interview Questions

If an interview or questions about your application are required, be ready to explain your study plans clearly.

You may be asked:

- Why Germany?
- Why this university?
- Why this particular course?
- How does the programme relate to your previous education?
- How will you finance your stay?
- What are your career plans?
- What do you know about your programme?

Avoid memorising artificial answers. Your responses should be truthful and consistent with your documents.

Common Germany Student Visa Mistakes

Students can reduce avoidable problems by checking their application carefully.

Common mistakes include:

- Using an outdated document checklist
- Missing APS requirements
- Providing incomplete financial proof
- Selecting an incorrect visa category
- Submitting inconsistent information
- Not checking language requirements
- Waiting too long to prepare documents
- Providing unclear information about the study plan
- Booking non-refundable travel before receiving the visa

Accuracy is more important than simply submitting an application quickly.

Can Students Work While Studying in Germany?

International students are allowed to work subject to the applicable German rules and restrictions.

However, students should not depend on future part-time employment to meet the initial financial-proof requirement for their visa.

The primary purpose of the visa is study, so your academic plan and financial preparation should be clear.

What Happens After Graduation?

Germany provides opportunities for international graduates who want to remain in the country and look for qualified employment.

Under current rules, eligible graduates can generally receive a residence permit for **up to 18 months** to search for qualified employment after completing their studies.

This can make Germany an attractive option for students who want to build an international career after graduation.
