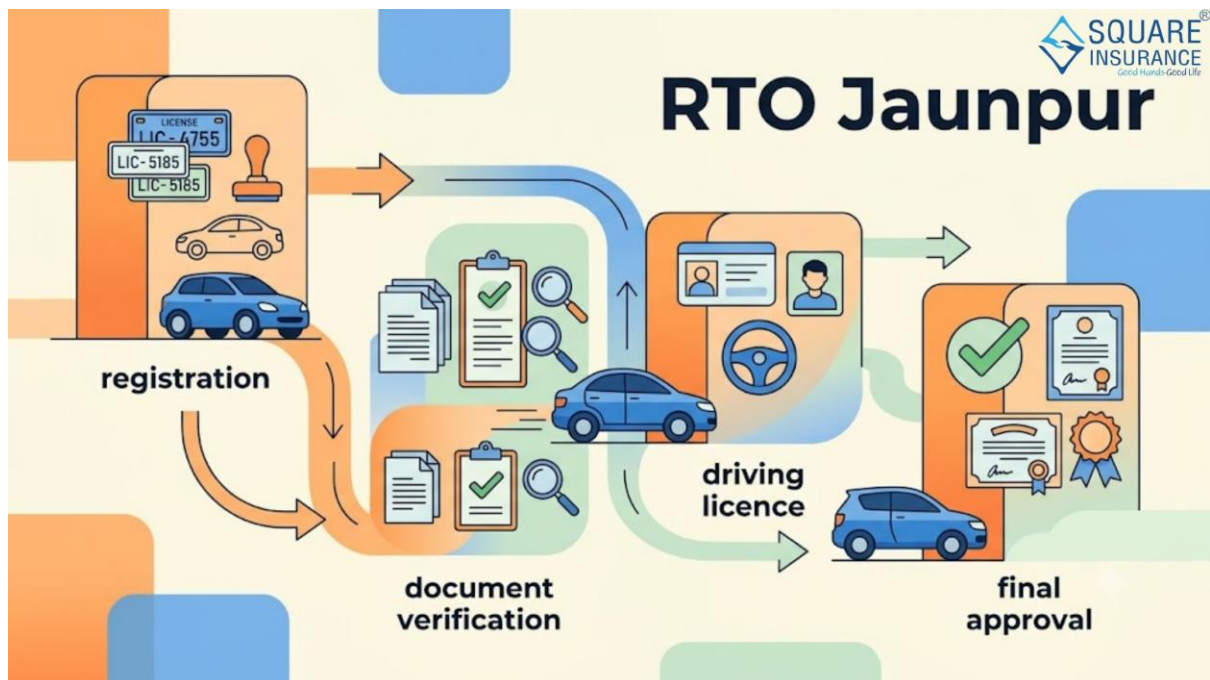


Why RTO Jaunpur Services Matter for Vehicle Owners
